

We wish we had an answer to this, but we still don't. The Romanian borders are closed to Americans right now because of the high numbers of COVID19 cases in the States. We have tried every avenue we can think of to find a way back, including emailing the Romanian consulate in Miami, emailing the American consulate, checking if we could enter via an intermediary country, obtaining humanitarian visas, and having friends in Romania contact border security for other options, etc. Please pray with us that the Lord will open a door for us to return, and that He will help us rest and find contentment in His sovereign plan, knowing that ALL THINGS work together for the good of those who love Him as we are conformed to Christ.

2020 has been a strange year for all of us, and a difficult year for many. We know families who have been impacted in significant ways by this year's events. It's a sobering thing to approach Thanksgiving knowing that many may feel a need to dig deep in order to foster a spirit of thankfulness. It's certainly not the same as being in person, but we are thankful for the flexibility we have.

We are also thankful for family - both our blood family and our spiritual family. We are thankful for all of the help all four grandparents have provided us with

vehicles and lodging, and for all the attention they've been able to give the grandkids. And we are thankful for our spiritual family, as churches and individuals continue to pray for us and for the ministry in Romania. We are grateful for all those who have reached out to us with encouragement, and we are thankful for so many who have continued to support us.

Without qualification, we are thankful, and we appreciate this time of year which forces us to face those situations which may otherwise create dissatisfaction within us. We would love for you to be praying along with us that we will rejoice always and give thanks in all circumstances. At the same time, please continue to pray with us that God's Kingdom comes on earth as it is in heaven, and that through these times, the dissonance we are feeling between what is and what we know ought to be will drive us to pray without ceasing for God's healing hand on our world, and for his gospel to be manifest to the nations.

- Please pray for one of the families on Codlea who are due to have a baby any day now, but have also come down with COVID. - Continue to pray for the church in Romania. It has been difficult to navigate the government regulations and ministry, and it has made search for a Romanian pastor even more difficult. This has been especially difficult on the leadership of the church, so please be in prayer for them. Like everyone else, we're trying to navigate what this all means for how we move forward.

- Please pray for us as we figure out how to connect from a distance. We are currently working on language tutoring, Bible studies, event planning for advent with Romania, while attending more online trainings and modules through MTW and trying to engage with the missionary community as to how we can effectively minister under COVID restrictions. Pray that we would gain wisdom as to how we can be effective from our current position.

- Please pray for us to have wisdom as to long-term planning. Like most others, we thought this COVID thing would blow over in a few months. At this point, we're realizing it could be another six months or more until things go back to "normal." We've been discussing plans with our teammates and have some plans we're looking to implement soon. Please pray for us as we plan.
