We will be Stateside for at least another month and would love to connect with you. Please reach out to us if you'd like to chat, ask questions, or pray together. We would love to encourage and connect however we are able.

What is God doing?

It's easy to ask this question right now. We sure are asking it a lot as we continue to wait to be able to return to Romania. With growing number of coronavirus cases in the States, and the European ban on American travelers, we still have no idea when we'll be able to return. And despite our petitions, God has not granted us our own space to live in for the foreseeable future. We are living again with Derek's parents. Our children are continuing to struggle with the constant instability, and poor Denton is now entirely confused about where we live and what "home" is.

Why, God? What are you doing?

But in the midst of these constant questions, we are grateful for some of His answers. Because God is still clearly working.

He is working on our language and missionary skills. Derek has made huge strides in his language abilities by attending online tutoring three times a week. He is encouraged by these gains, since he knows that it will make him a more effective helper in Romania. Plus, we are studying Storytelling to help us become better evangelists to the largely illiterate Roma people with whom we work.

He is working on the hearts of our Romanian church members.

Since the beginning of the pandemic, the young couples have stepped up and taken ownership of many things in the church. Of their own accord, they planned and implemented a twice-weekly prayer meeting via Facebook Messenger, where we share prayer requests, Scripture, songs, and other encouragements with one another. And we pray together. Two of the ladies are continuing to find ways to minister to girls in orphanages in our area even when they cannot see them face-to-face. And they have worked together to figure out safe ways to meet in person in smaller groups for church so as to comport with the governmental regulations for meeting together. And He's preparing new parents, as two of our friends are halfway through their pregnancy with their first baby boy. The church is growing through covenant children! We have prayed for our church members to implicate themselves more in the leadership of the church, and we are seeing great fruits of these prayers!

He is continuing to equip us through the body in the States. It is an interesting time to be Stateside, not just because of the virus, but because of the racial tensions which have come to a head. It's amazing how all problems are problems intrinsic to humanity as a whole, and rarely isolated in a particular culture. Much of what we're hearing, seeing, and learning from our Black brothers and sisters about their experiences in the States are quite similar to the experiences of and systemic issues towards the Roma in Romania. It's

at least true at the heart level, though it plays out differently in different societal structures. So as we continue to learn about American history and the Black community while also seeking to learn more about Romania and the Roma community, we're finding that we're seeing the human heart and human need in both situations. Please pray for us as we seek to humbly learn, and as we seek to be vessels which find effective ways to minister to others wherever God has us at the moment.

He is working on the hearts of our sending community here in the States. It takes a lot of love and sacrifice for our parents to allow us to live with them and to help with the kids so much. Even things that are joyful, like playing with grandkids, can become a lot more difficult when we're all together in a small space. He is reminding people to pray for us and give sacrificially to continue our funding even in the midst of uncertain financial times. We continue to feel cared for by our sending community.



There is no sugarcoating the fact that this is a very difficult time for our family, as it is for so many; and one that is coming on the heels of four years of other difficult circumstances. But we continue to seek the Lord's face. He is always faithful.

PRAISE AND PRAYER:


- Please continue with us in prayer for our teammates, the <u>Ebbers</u>, as they must creatively find ways to raise support during this pandemic.
